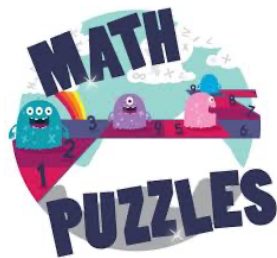
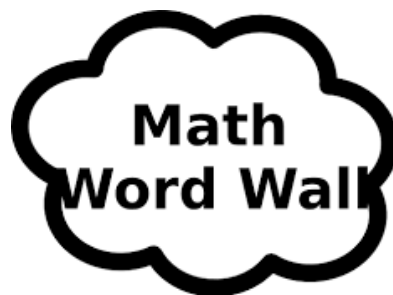

Each students must create at least 3 Posters with 3 different Math Terms.


See my example:

Distributive Property
